... an angel of the Lord appeared to Joseph in a dream. 'Get up,' he said, 'take the child and his mother and escape to Egypt. Stay there until I tell you, for Herod is going to search for the child to kill him.' Matthew 2:13 (TNIV) 1. When God speaks he expects us ...... 2. Often, the 'simple asks' from God ......
